

PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

Martin Sullivan, Inc ("Martin Sullivan, Inc", "We", "Our", "Us") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, that you provide to us, or that is provided to us by a Subscriber to our Services (under the brand name Martin Sullivan, Inc), will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting martinsullivan.com or any other website owned or operated by Martin Sullivan, Inc (collectively "Martin Sullivan, Inc Websites"), you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

2. Information We May Collect From You

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information you give us. You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our Martin Sullivan, Inc Websites or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail, or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register to use our site, subscribe to our Service, participate in any discussion boards, forums, or other social media functions on our site or enter a competition, promotion, or survey and when you report a problem with our site. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address, and phone number, financial and credit card information, personal description and photograph. We also store the Content that you upload or provide to the Service in order to provide you with the features and functionality of the Service.
- Information we receive from other sources. We may receive information about you from individuals or corporate entities which are Subscribers to our Service ("Subscribers"), where you are to be designated a user of our Service. We may receive information about you if you use any of the other websites we operate or the other services we provide. We are also working closely with third parties (including, for example, subcontractors in technical, payment, and delivery services, advertising networks, insurers, insurance brokers, analytics providers, search information providers) and may receive information about you from them, subject to your agreements with them.

Please note that our Service requires you to provide us with certain personal data. If you choose to withhold any personal data requested by us, it may not be possible for you to gain access to certain parts of the site and for us to respond to your queries.

3. Cookies

In order to provide you with customized service, we make use of "cookies." Cookies are

essentially files that help us identify your computer and respond to it. We don't use cookies to pry, but merely to ensure that you have the best and most efficient experience when shopping on our site. For more information on how cookies and other technology work, go to our Cookie Policy.

4. Tracking Technologies

Technologies such as: cookies, beacons, tags, and scripts are used by Martin Sullivan, Inc and our marketing partners, affiliates, or analytics or online customer support service providers.

These technologies are used in analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movements around the site, and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We may receive reports based on the use of these technologies by these companies on an individual as well as aggregated basis.

5. Analytics/Log Files

Log Files - As is true of most websites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exist pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and/or clickstream data.

We may combine this automatically collected log information with other information we collect about you. We do this to improve services we offer you, to improve marketing, analytics, or site functionality.

6. Uses Made of the Information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- Information you give to us. We will use this information:
 - to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, or between a Subscriber and us, and to provide you with the information, products, and services that you or a Subscriber request from us;
 - to provide you with information about other goods and services we or our third-party affiliates or business partners offer;
 - to provide you with information about goods or services we feel may interest you, including providing you with information about goods and services similar to those that were the subject of a previous sale or negotiations of a sale to you. If you are a new customer, we may contact you by electronic means;
 - to notify you about changes to our Service; and
 - to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- Information we collect about you. We will use this information:
 - to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between a Subscriber and use;
 - to administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical, and survey purposes;

- to improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
 - to allow you to participate in interactive features of our Services, when you choose to do so;
 - as part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure;
 - to measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you;
 - to provide you with information about other goods and services we or our third-party affiliates or business partners offer; and
 - to make suggestions and recommendations to you, Subscribers and other users of our site about goods or services that may interest you or them.
- Information we receive from other sources. We may combine this information with information you give us and information we collect from you. We may use this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

7. Disclosure of Your Information

We may share your personal information with any member of our group, which includes our subsidiaries, affiliates, business partners, agents, and other designated third parties.

We will not share personal information about you or any Content with any third parties, except as described in this Private Policy or in connection with the Services. Data we share with third parties may be in aggregate form or may be personally identifiable. We may share your information with selected third parties, including:

- Business partners, vendors, suppliers, and subcontractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with you or a corporate entity which is a Subscriber.
- For sales and marketing purposes related to the Service or selected third-party affiliates and business partners.
- Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimization of our site.
- Aggregated demographic information from our user base with or without personally identifiable data.

In certain situations, Martin Sullivan, Inc may be required to disclose personal data in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements. We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If Martin Sullivan, Inc or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms and conditions of service and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Martin Sullivan, Inc, our

customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

- If Martin Sullivan, Inc is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, you will be notified via e-mail and/or a prominent notice on our website of any change in ownership or uses of your personal information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your personal information.

Some of our pages utilize framing techniques to serve content to/from our partners while preserving the look and feel of our site. Please be aware that you are providing your personal information to third parties and not to Martin Sullivan, Inc.

8. User Access and Choice

Martin Sullivan, Inc will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide you reasonable access to any of your personally identifying information we maintain at your request. The data that we collect from you will be stored at a destination within the United States. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

All information you provide to us is stored on secure servers in a controlled environment with limited access. Any payment transactions will be made using encrypted technology. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password that enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

While no transmission of information via the internet is completely secure, we take reasonable measures to protect your personal data, and we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

11. Your Rights
